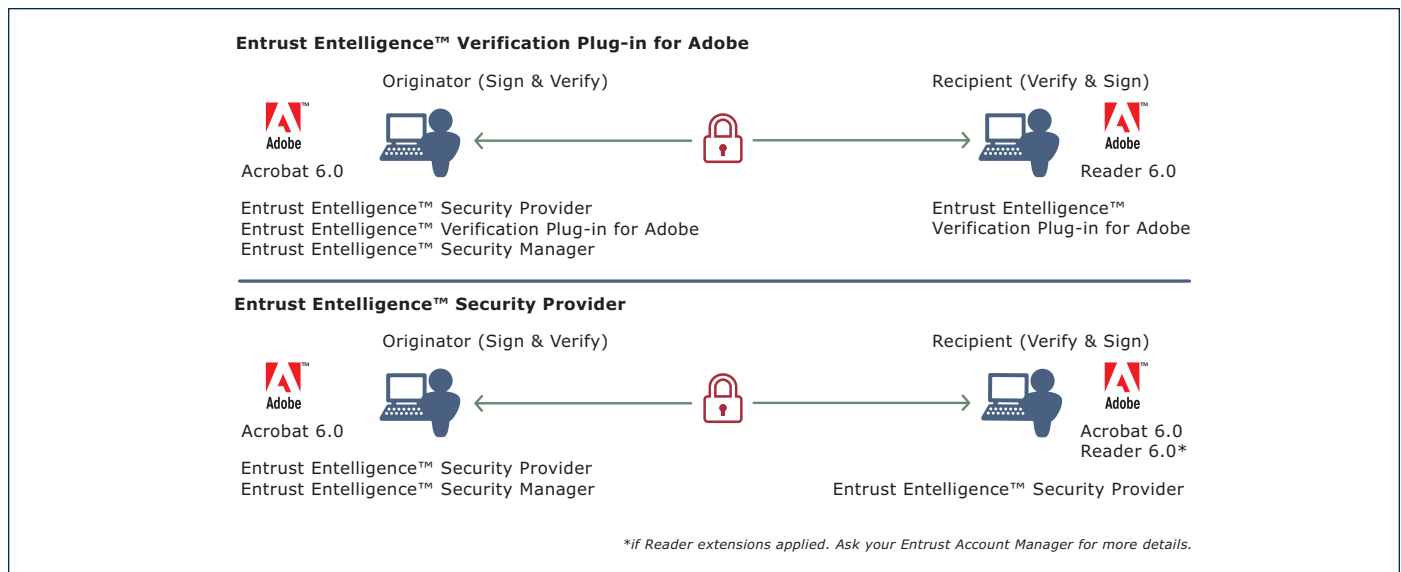
Entrust Intelligence Verification Plug-in for Adobe

Entrust Intelligence Verification Plug-in for Adobe provides organizations with the ability to digitally sign, verify and encrypt PDF files. Through seamless integration into either Adobe Acrobat or Adobe Reader, the FIPS 140-2 certified plug-in provides "government-strength" security to documents containing high-value information. The plug-in is designed

to meet stringent government security standards that focus around digital signature, encryption and path validation standards—all of which contribute to the level of document security. For customers requiring secure PDF correspondence with US government agencies, the plug-in is also compliant with the U.S. Federal Bridge Certification Authority.

Entrust Intelligence Security Provider

Entrust Intelligence Security Provider leverages capabilities within Adobe Acrobat and Adobe Reader to digitally sign documents using the native security functionality found within Microsoft Windows. Security Provider enables complete lifecycle management (initial enrollment, key rollover, key back-up and key recovery) of the Entrust digital identities leveraged in the application of digital signatures within Adobe Acrobat or Adobe Reader. The automated management of these functions relieves the end-user from the responsibility of security management—leading to increased usability, reduced support and greater scalability.
